This lake is somewhat urban, however, due to its size, it hasn't been overfished. Any boat will put the angler at a severe advantage (but you should have one already if you fish Texas waters). Head up under the bridge pylons (the southern bridge), and fish live minnows or jigs about 12-18 feet down, and wait for the bite. It's a great spot (in the shade of the bridge, out of the Texas sun) to learn the basics of crappie fishing.
