It was 27.25 inches long and 19.5 inches around. Taylor was fishing in five feet of water with a red lizard. Taylor fish is the 23rd to be entered into the Budweiser ShareLunker program from Sam Rayburn Reservoir. Only two lakes in Texas have had more ShareLunker entries: Lake Fork and Lake Alan Henry. Sam Rayburn now trails Alan Hen
