My Story

Caught March 9 by Ricky Culverhouse of Waco while fishing in a Robinson Bass Club tournament, the fish weighed 13.87 pounds and was 25.5 inches long and 21.5 inches in girth. Since 1971 TPWD has stocked 400,000 largemouth bass and 543,496 Florida largemouth bass into Lake Waco. The previous Lake Waco record largemouth bass weighed 12.89 pounds and was caught in 1996. Culverhouse caught the fish on a black-and-red flake Baby Brushhog in about six feet of water. He had cast to the same area hal
